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IDI Accommodations Policy

IDI is committed to providing reasonable accommodations for all persons with permanent and temporary disabilities. Accommodations are determined on a case-by-case basis through an interactive process with the Directors of Education.

Accommodations are required by law under Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act and the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA). Accommodations are provided to minimize the impact of the functional limitations of a disability in a classroom. Civil rights laws protect individuals from discrimination but do not require special privileges or unreasonable accommodation. Accommodations may be temporary or permanent as denoted on the letter of accommodations. Students with authorized accommodations will provide a Letter of Accommodations document to each instructor informing them of the academic adjustments approved for each course. Students are encouraged to discuss their accommodations with the instructor. However, the student is not required to disclose or discuss specific disability-related information.

After the necessary accommodations are made, the student should be graded according to the same standards used for other Interior Designers Institute students.
