Project one – Material Presentation

You are required to have the following content in project one:

- A clear layout design idea
- A background related to the material
- An objective focus
- 2 close up images
- 2 images installed
- Material Name
- Cost SF
- Cost per SF installed
- Manufacturer's address, phone, and logo
- Code information: Smoke production, Flame spread
- Annotation showing 3 reasons supporting the objective focus

Project two - Architectural Style

You are required to have the following content in project two:

- A clear layout design idea
- A background related to the style
- An objective focus
- 3 images of buildings or interiors showing this style
- 3 characteristics of this style shown with images
- 1 image of an architect or designer known for this style
- 1 plan showing this style
- 1 building section showing this style
- Product or furniture related to this style
- Fashion, or Art related to this style
- Use of selection tools to isolate completely one content item
- Style name in a related font
- Annotation showing 3 reasons supporting the objective focus
- Annotation showing the layout design idea
- Annotation showing the three characteristics of the style
- Annotation showing the type of selection tool
- Annotation showing labels for all other content
