Interior Designers Institute's Interior Design Program leading to the Bachelor of Arts in Interior Design Degree is accredited by the **Council for Interior Design Accreditation** (CIDA).

The Bachelor of Arts Degree in Interior Design Program is a 4-year degree scheduled on a term/quarter system. The student has the option of completing this Program in 30 to 54 months.

The following data was collected using institutional records and an alumni survey that was administered after the class of 2018 graduated. 100% of alumni responded to the survey.
